

Year 6 Topic Homework – Half Term 3

As part of their learning this half term, Year 6 are to progress their knowledge of earthquakes; World War 2; and dialogue completing homework tasks based on these. The due date for the projects of their choice is the final week of the half term.

It is expected that children complete at least three of the following options:

- Create a poster of the layers of the Earth to explain how earthquakes are caused.
- Make a model of a cross section of the Earth to show Earth's different layers.
- Research how humans monitor earthquakes and create a fact file about them.
- Create a poster with instructions on what to do in the event of an earthquake.
- Make a model of an air raid shelter.
- Write a diary as an evacuee in World War 2.
- Create a rations book or National Identity Card which would have been used in World War 2.
- Create a propaganda poster to get citizens to enlist in the British Army in WW2.
- Create a piece of art on the air raids.
- Research what happened to Birmingham during WW2 and create a fact file about it.
- Write a set of instructions to teach someone a dance (PE topic)
