Year 6 Topic Homework – Half Term 4

As part of their learning this half term, Year 6 are to progress their knowledge of where our food comes from; Animals including humans in Science; and story writing completing homework tasks based on these. The due date for the projects of their choice is the final week of the half term.

It is expected that children complete at least three of the following options:

- Make a model of a human heart. Can you include key facts about the heart to accompany your model?
- Write a story using Percy Jackson as inspiration – who stole Zeus' lightning bolt and how?
- Where does my food come from? With your parents' permission, investigate the origin of foods in your home. Create a poster displaying where these foods have come from. You could put a map at the centre of the poster or split it into sections for the different locations.
- Create a model of a mode of transport using Tinkercad – Class Code: 7MQXCFVTH
- Create a leaflet to inform people how to stay healthy. This can include exercise tips, food and drink advice and things that people should avoid.
- Create a collage of a piece of food using recycled materials.
- Research what Fairtrade is and make a poster to inform others about its benefits.
- Write a set of instructions to teach someone how to play a net and wall sport.
