

Forestdale Primary School Sports Premium Planned Spend 2021/2022

Total amount for this academic year 2021/2022 £ 17,780

Targets for academic year 2021/22

- Experience days run for school cohort covering activities and sports that are not currently used within the PE curriculum.
- Catch up and intervention lessons in swimming for Year 6 due to reduced time in lessons affected by Covid-19. Children in this cohort to go swimming for more sessions in the school year (3 half terms). Improve percentage of children who can swim required distance by end of Year 6. Next year, spread the range of year groups who go swimming to attempt to build progression over time and, as a future result, reduce the necessity for as many swimming lessons in Year 6.
- Alternative active learning activities to the Run a Mile – further purchasing of equipment and schemes to encourage activity of children, progression and evidence.
- The reimplementation of afterschool clubs to encourage and offer experiences to cohort of sports not covered in curriculum areas.
- To increase participation in activities with other schools in area.
