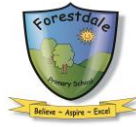


FORESTDALE PRIMARY SCHOOL

Mobile and Smart Technologies Policy

Forestdale Primary School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff to share this commitment.

At Forestdale Primary School we do not allow mobile phones to be brought in by children unless with prior agreement with the Head Teacher.

If a parent wishes a child to bring a mobile phone or smart device into school, please discuss this with the Head Teacher. If agreed, the phone will need to be handed into the office each morning and then collected. Children are not allowed to use these on the school premises.

With increasing changes in technology functionality on devices can be varied. Any device which has either phone capabilities, recording (video or sound) or camera functionality is not allowed in school. This includes watches and fitness bands if they have any of this functionality.
