Welcome to the first Galliford Try newsletter to keep you up to date with the construction of the new Forestdale Primary School on Frankley Beeches Road.

Galliford Try, in partnership with Birmingham City Council (BCC), Acivico, and Forestdale Primary School, has been selected to deliver the new school premises. The project is being led by Birmingham City Council, with Acivico acting as the Council's project management team, working closely with all stakeholders to successfully deliver the new facility.

Construction works will commence on **Monday, 7th September 2026**, with completion scheduled for **Late 2027**.

Initial activities will include site setup, installation of temporary fencing, and enabling works, leading into the main construction phase. The project involves

the construction of a single-storey primary school, along with a sports field and a Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA).

Over the coming months, you will see groundworks carried out during September and October, followed by the steel frame forming the main structure of the building from November.

The site will open from 7:30 am to allow workers to arrive and prepare, but construction activities will not begin until 8:00 am. Standard working hours will be Monday to Friday, 8:00 am – 6:00 pm, with occasional Saturday work if required.

We will issue a project update every three months throughout the construction period, ensuring you remain fully informed. We look forward to keeping you updated as the project progresses.
